



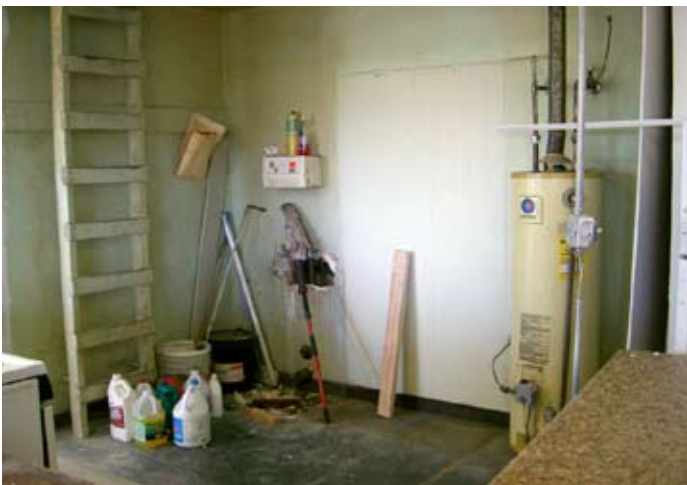

- To be a proxy on aviation matters of community concern for its membership.





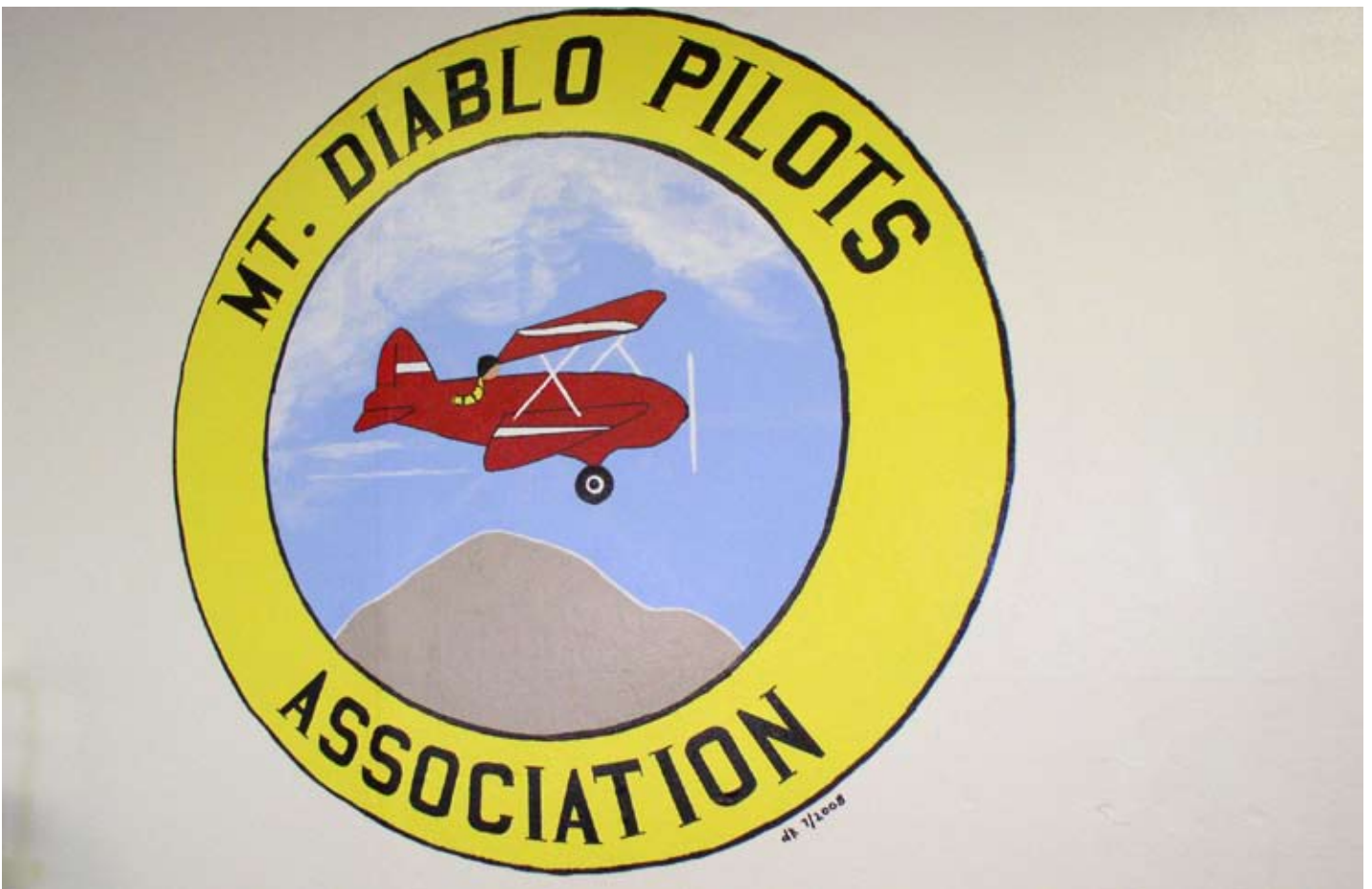












# *Page of Fame*
